What is CEO?

SVCEO (Sangamon Valley Creating Entrepreneurial

Opportunities) is based on the successful program in Effingham, Illinois. The communities of Argenta-Oreana, Bement, Cerro Gordo, Deland-Weldon & Monticello School Districts have worked together to establish the SVCEO program to serve students from their high schools, beginning in the fall of 2019.





The SVCEO Program:

- Is funded by business investors, and organized by the SVCEO Board which is not part of any school board or school district.
- Is open to high school seniors from Argenta-Oreana, Bement, Cerro Gordo, Deland-Weldon & Monticello High Schools
- Select Students through a rigorous, blind application process.
- Meets for 90 minutes each day and provides 2 high school credits.
- Utilizes area businesses as classrooms; does not meet on a school campus.
- Each year is hosted by/ hosts more than 50 area businesses and guest speakers.
- Provides an opportunity for each student to start their own business.
- Provides a mentor from the business community for each SVCEO student.
- Hosts an annual Trade Show to showcase students businesses.






